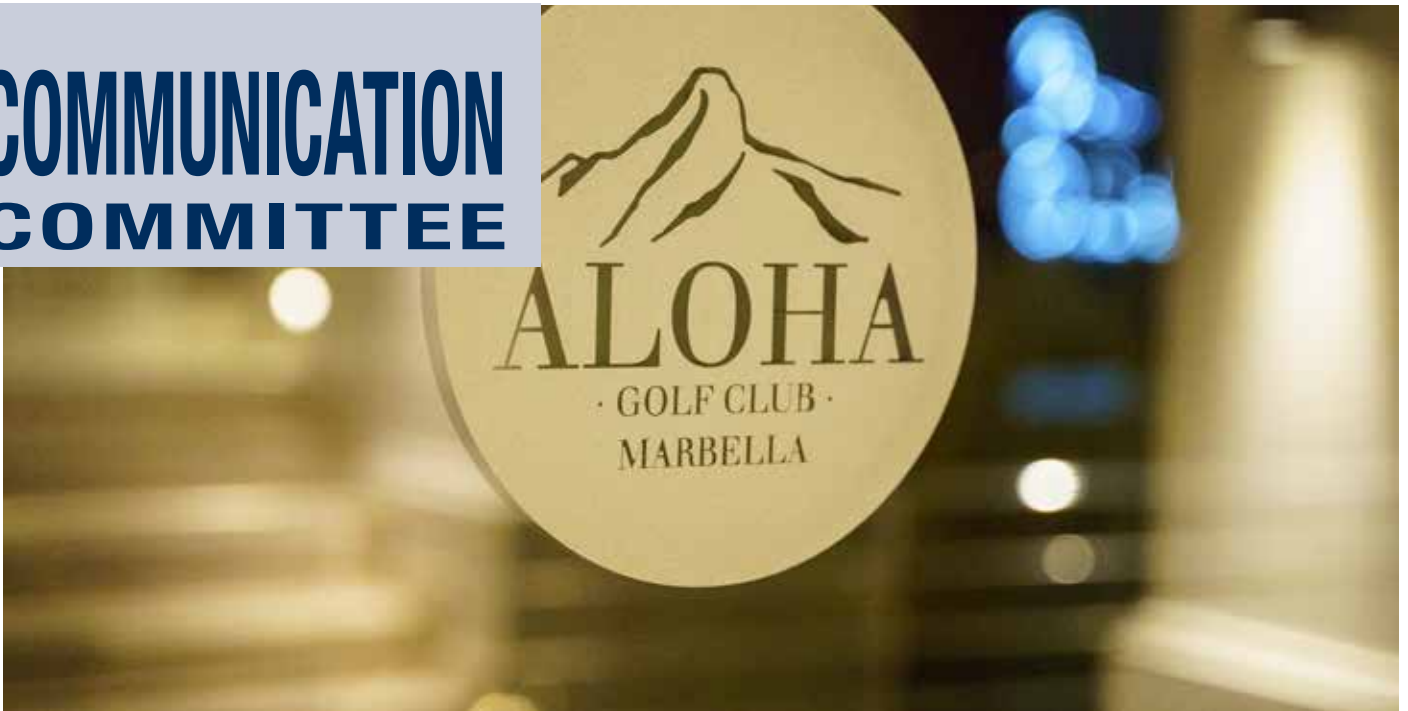


COMMUNICATION COMMITTEE
